**GPS ELECTRONIC MONITORING ORDER**

The Court finds that ELECTRONIC MONITORING is the least restrictive condition of release. The Court further finds less restrictive conditions WOULD NOT ensure the safety of any person(s) or the community or ensure Defendant's appearance in court. The Court has set forth the basis for this finding in the record.

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the above Defendant shall comply with Electronic Monitoring as administered by the Office of Statewide Pretrial Services (OSPS).

**The Defendant shall:**

1. Have an electronic monitoring device affixed to their body at all times.
2. Charge the device, not tamper with nor damage the device. Defendant is financially responsible for any lost or damaged equipment.
3. Obtain OSPS approval for any designated address change.
4. Immediately update OSPS and/or the Circuit Clerk of any contact information changes.
5. Permit OSPS access to Defendant's designated address to verify compliance with this order (730 ILCS 5/5-8A-4(B)).
6. Comply with the following type of electronic monitoring (please select only one):

☐ **B. Home Confinement.** The Defendant shall remain inside the designated address and abide by the OSPS' guidelines. The Defendant shall be allowed to leave the designated residence for basic life activities pursuant to 730 ILCS 5/5-8A-4(A-1) and consistent with OSPS guidance. Basic life activities include but are not limited to the following: employment, medical treatment, counseling, educational programs, religious services, groceries/basic life necessities, attorney visits, court appearances, routine home activities, court directed community service programs, funeral services, etc. Defendant shall provide 48 hours advance notice to OSPS and obtain approval for any additional movement(s).
